- Submissions are sent to communications@cw1.ca.
- Deadline for submissions is December 31, 2015.

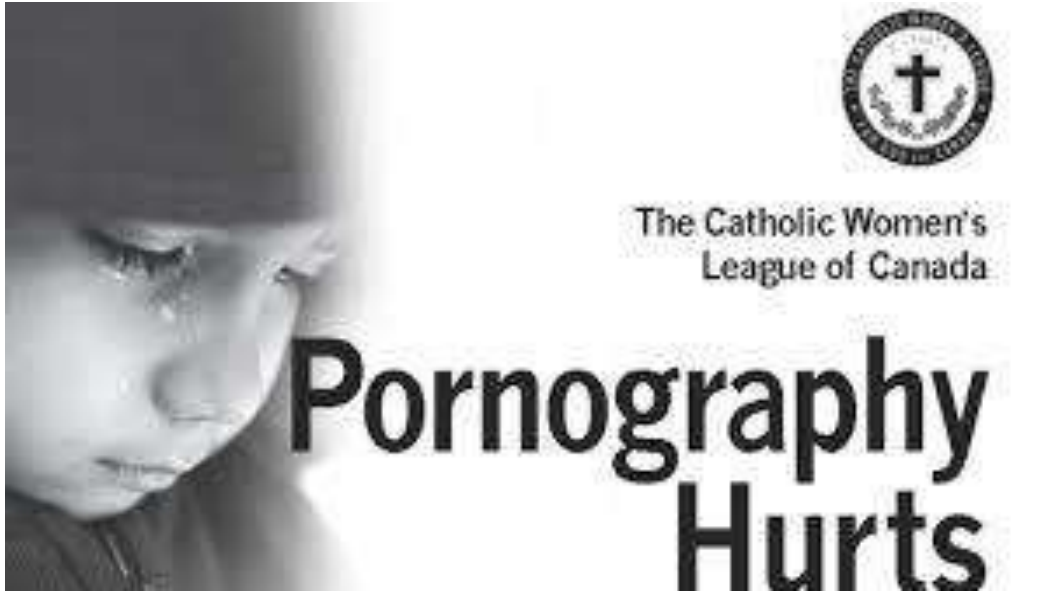
Pornography Hurts Campaign
